Call our dispatcher from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm a MINIMUM OF 2 BUSINESS DAYS IN ADVANCE

to schedule a seat on the bus. Please have the *address* of the location you need transportation to when you call.

Call in advance to CANCEL a reservation. Messages can be left after hours. DO NOT call the drivers directly! Please be ready at the scheduled pick up time!

Drivers are only able to wait a maximum of 5 minutes after the scheduled pick up time.

SHOPPING SCHEDULE SUPERMARKET RUNS - 1 HOUR - MAX 5 PEOPLE 4 BAGS OR LARGE ITEMS LIMIT

The fee is **\$1.75** each way. A book of 10 passes can be purchased for **\$15**. A book of passes makes a great gift for any senior in your life that needs transportation!

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR WHEELCHAIR PASSENGERS: Wheelchair passengers who need assistance upon arrival to their destination should arrange a companion to ride with them since the drivers are unable to escort passengers beyond their arrival point. If a companion is unavailable to you, arrangements can be made.




